The program also offers education and training opportunities designed to foster clean energy technology adoption, promote green jobs and growth, and strengthen native communities.

The Renewable Energy Resources include:

Potential carbon sequestration areas; biomass; geothermal; hydrogen; ethanol; solar; wind; and hydropower. The Program also addresses energy efficiency.
